Caversham Champions to End Loneliness

This group was formed following a workshop in Caversham library a year ago
run jointly by Reading Voluntary Action and our Missional Innovations Team
(MIT) comprising members from our 2 churches and the local Caversham
Thameside parish with whom we have been involved in PMC.
